Also a designated area will be set aside in the Daunt's Square/ Grand Parade area for the Sick and Disabled, and His Lordship will impart a Special Blessing for the Sick to those in attendance.

This new arrangement means that women and children can now walk in the Procession with the men and boys.

NOTE: There will be no May Procession this year. Weather permitting, it is hoped to hold a Procession in connection with the Jubilee Celebrations.

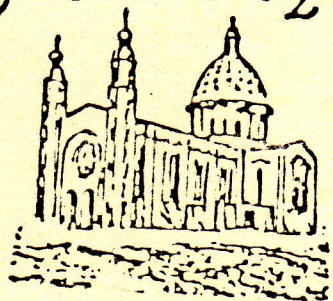
You are asked to remember in your prayers the four students who will be ordained to the Priesthood for these dioceses on Saturday next, 8th June, in the Cathedral.
