ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING: St. Joseph's Young Priests' Society AGM is in the Crypt next Wednesday evening at 8.00 P.M.

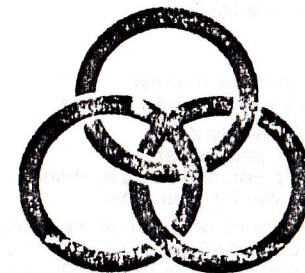

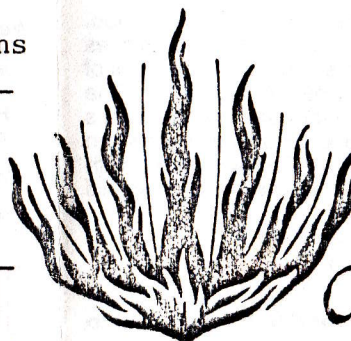
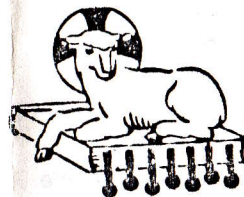


PREFACE OF THE HOLY TRINITY
