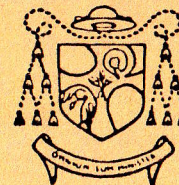
COLLECTION NEXT SUNDAY

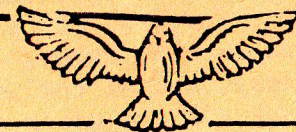
My dear people of Ballineaspig,
