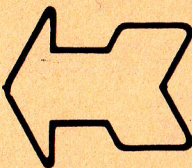


WHEN YOU ARE making your New Year's Resolutions, maybe you might keep the following suggestions in mind.....



BAPTISMS Saturdays at 6.30 P.M.
Please notify the priest in advance.
We suggest you give one week's notice.

WEDDINGS If you intend to get married you MUST give THREE MONTH'S NOTICE. This rule applies in all parts of Ireland, and is strictly adhered to.

HOLY COMMUNION When going to Communion in the Parish Church, please approach from the aisle into which the Minister is facing. We ask you not to approach him or her from the side - this causes much confusion.

Coeliacs who attend Mass here on Sundays are asked to make themselves known to any of the priests. Special arrangements can then be made for them to receive Communion from the chalice.

Those who find themselves sick or housebound are invited to share in Holy Communion each Sunday. This can be arranged with a Priest or a local Minister of the Eucharist.

MASS STIPENDS The Diocesan Mass Stipend is £ 4 , since July 1985. Allowances will of course be made in the case of those who cannot afford this amount.

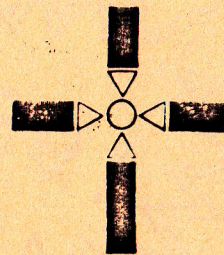

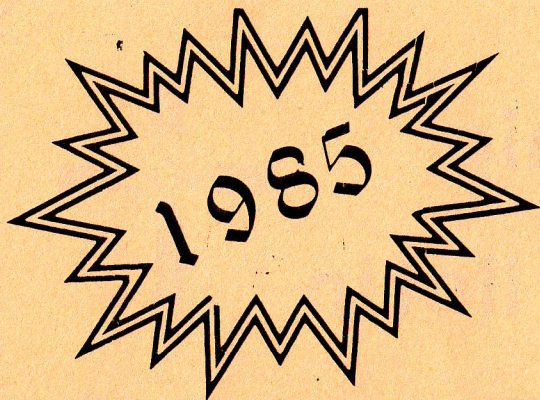

JAN. 1985:.....VOTE ON MISSALETTES for use in church took place.
259 voted for the missalette with the full text.
254 voted for the missalette with readings only.
As a result, it was decided to alternate the two types, twice yearly.

FEB. 1985:.....FIRST JUBILEE MEETING took place on the 18th.

MAR. 1985:.....SACRAMENT OF THE SICK celebrated in the Parish Church on the 23rd.

APRIL 1985:.....SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION was celebrated by Bishop Murphy at Dennehy's Cross on the 30th.

MAY 1985:.....FIRST COMMUNION was given on the 11th.

✠ Sister M. Assumpta Whelan, of the Poor Clare Monastery, College Road, died on the 3rd. She was in the 50th year of her Religious Profession. Interred in the Monastery grounds on the 6th.

JUNE 1985:.....EUCCHARISTIC PROCESSION on the 9th. There was a fourfold increase in our parish contingent.

Sister Philip, Superior, moves to Mayfield Convent. Sister Coirle replaces her as Superior.

JULY 1985:.....Death of Tim Morrissey, gardener at St Catherine's Convent for over twenty years.

SEPT. 1985:.....BALLINEASPAIG PARISH BULLETIN published for the first time in new format on 1st.

Week of Celebrations beginning Sunday 22nd with Mass by Bishop Murphy. JUBILEE DAY celebrated on WEDNESDAY 25th. Over nine hundred attend Mass. Social follows at Mount Mercy. Also Youth Mass & Disco, Mass for housebound and Jubilee Concert.

OCT. 1985:.....JUBILEE NOVENA by the Redemptorist Fathers, preceded by visitation of all homes of Parish.

DEC. 1985:.....Presentation of Papal 'Benemerenti' medal to Michael Waldron, Church Sacristan for 22 years. Bishop Buckley attended the celebration, on the 4th. Over two hundred people attended a Social at St. Catherine's, which followed the Presentation.
