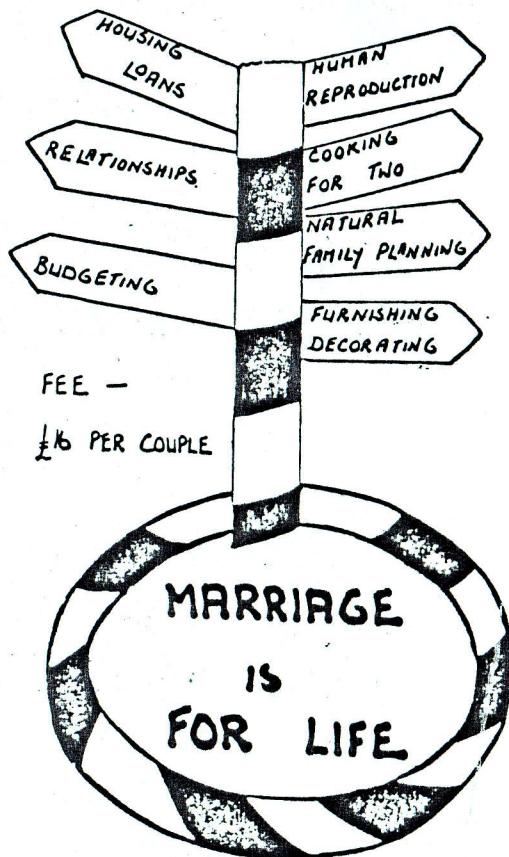

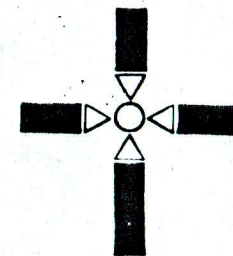

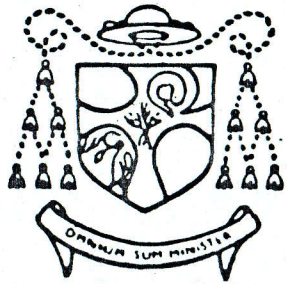

# EMIGRATION



Dear People of Cork and Ross, In the past couple of months, almost 400 young people from the Cork area have emigrated to England. These are the people who have made contact with the Irish Centres in Britain. Probably, there are many more.

I am very concerned about our young people, who feel they must go abroad for employment. Often, they turn up at the Irish Centres unable to find work, their money all spent and with nothing left to pay for accommodation. The feed-back from these Centres is disturbing.

To try to meet this growing problem, I have now set up a Counselling Service for Emigrants and I have appointed Fr. Michael Nicholas, O.F.M., of St. Francis, Liberty St., Cork, to organise this service.

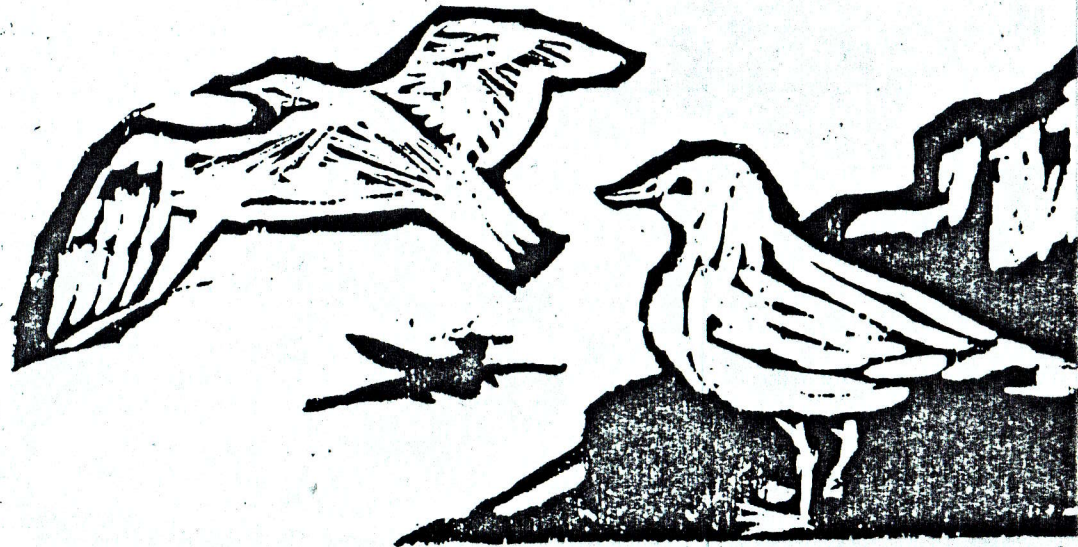
Through its regular contact with the Irish Centres and other agencies in Britain, the Counselling Service will offer guidance and advice to those, who are determined to emigrate. Unless young people are going to relatives or to a definite employment, the Service will discourage them from emigrating. It will have information available on projects in the dioceses that have been initiated for the unemployed.

Advice on job opportunities and accommodation in Britain will not be part of this new Service.

I commend this new Counselling Service for Emigrants to your support and your prayers. May the Day come quickly when there will be no need for this Service!

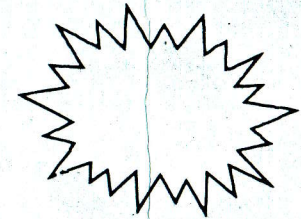
