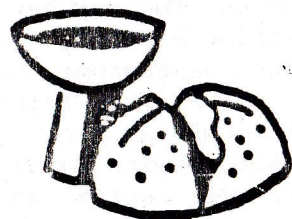


THE EASTER TRIDUUM

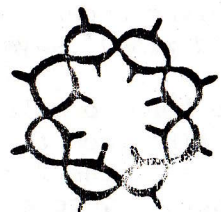


Holy Thursday

Confessions: Before and after Ceremonies.

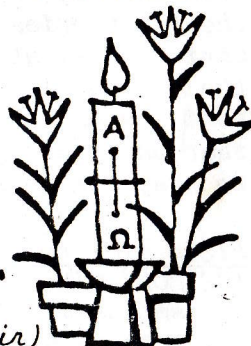

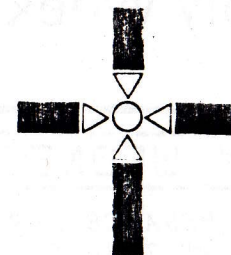
