### Referendum

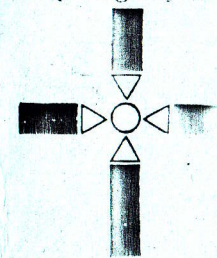

THE DIOCESAN MISSION to Peru has come of age! It is 21-years since the late Bishop Lucey courageously undertook responsibility for a shanty-town on the edge of the City of Trujillo, in Peru.

IN THE INTERVENING YEARS, much has happened - many lives have been touched by that decision, and the continuing commitment since. For 21-years, the Sisters and Priests have been working every day to fulfil the command of Christ - to preach the Gospel to His people.

IMPLICIT IN THIS COMMAND is the need to provide for the poor and the sick. Jesus Himself spent much of His time caring for these people. So, too, a large part of the time and energy of our Missionaries in Peru is devoted to feeding the hungry, caring for the sick and elderly, and developing self-help projects.

JUST AS THE provision of the social services education, health and food - demand money, so, too, does the preaching of the Gospel. The ongoing expenses of the Mission come to approximately £ 200,000 each year. The Mission has depended totally for 21-years on the continuing generosity of the people of Cork & Ross.

IT IS WITH RENEWED CONFIDENCE that I approach the people of these dioceses on the occasion of our Annual Collection for Peru, to be held next Sunday. Your contributions will assure the continuing spread of the Gospel among a people who are eternally grateful for what has already been done.
