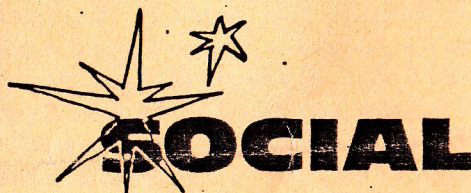
NEXT SUNDAY is the third Sunday of

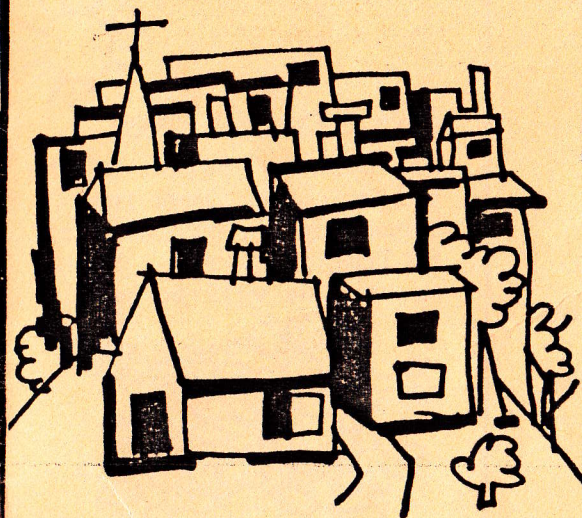

MY DEAR PARISHIONERS.

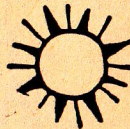

Their care, concern and practical help in taking the family into their homes and providing help to get a home together was in the best traditions of a caring Christian community. The prompt response of Corporation officials deserves commendation also - and happily temporary accommodation near their home has been provided.
