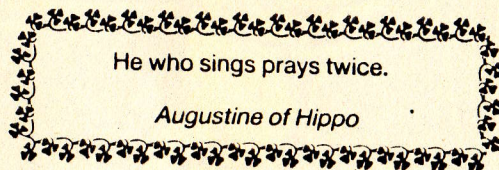
## MUSIC
