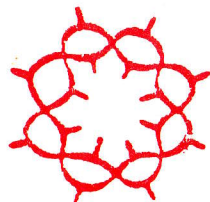

Confessions before and after Ceremonies.

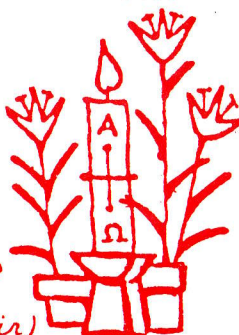

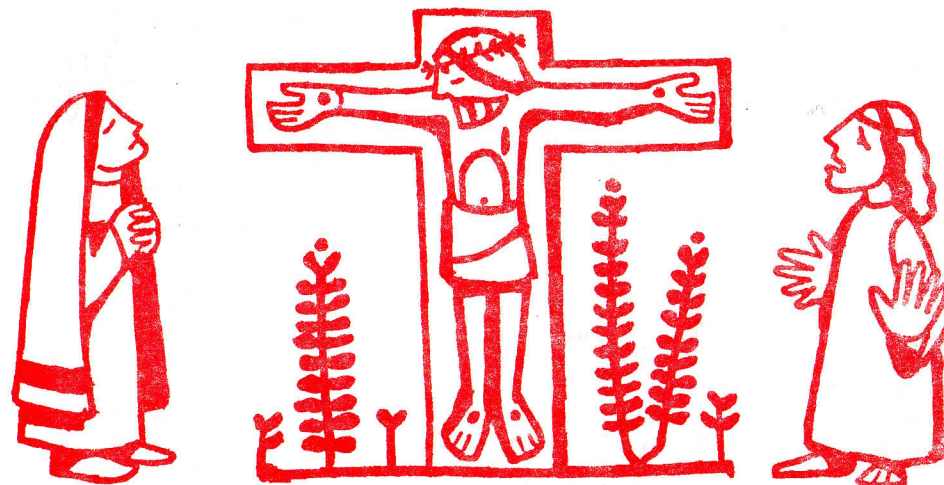
