A BRIEF TOUR OF THE CHURCH

THE CHURCH of the Holy Spirit was
opened in 1960. Neo-classical in
style, it is 193 feet long, 98
feet wide and can seat 1100 people.

Begin your visit at the gallery
inside the main entrance. Look at
the symbolic medallions: Fleur-de-
Lys (Holy Trinity and Our Lady);
Keys and Cross (role of St. Peter);
Two Birds (Providence of God);
Star and the Sea (Our Lady);
Barque (Church); Host and Chalice
(Eucharist); Pelican (Redemption).
The panels of the Rose Window above
portray the Seven Sacraments. An
eighth panel depicts Christ the
source of Justice and Mercy.

Stand under the dome whose apex
is 110 feet above the floor. On
the columns below, the four evan-
gelists are represented by winged
figures and their symbols of man,
lion, ox and eagle. The mosaic
of Pentecost behind the main altar
was designed and executed by the
Italian artist Romeo Battistella.

After you leave the church pause
at the low wall on your left to see
the statue of Mary and Child by the
Cork sculptor Seamus Murphy.
