## FROM OUR PARISH TEAM

*The Dean writes*

There is Election fever in the air. Not the Presidential race - a far more important event for our Parish - a new Pastoral Council. The present Council completes its term of office in October. We need a replacement - or the same again, if they, and you, so decide. Briefly the plan is this:

1. A special voting paper will be included with your Bulletin to the homes next month - October.
2. Everybody over 18 may nominate a person to represent your district on the Council - anyone over 18 is also eligible for nomination.

3. Those nominated in each district will meet and elect from themselves one person to represent the district on the Council.
4. Please nominate the person who in your estimation will best represent your views. Think it over - it's a serious decision.
5. This method of election is different from previous years, and it's hoped those nominated will take an active interest in their own area.
6. The Parish Council fulfils a most important role in our Parish. We invite your help and co-operation to make this a vibrant community, where your views are heard and valued - and where you feel you really belong.
