## OUR PARISH PRIEST WRITES:

### “CHRIST IS ALIVE”



Lent began on the 22nd February, Ash Wednesday, and now it is over for another year. Last week we journeyed with Jesus through his suffering, death and aloneness. Today, Easter Sunday, we celebrate his resurrection. Jesus is alive! When the Apostles, the women and the two disciples on the road to Emmaus met the Risen Jesus, their lives were changed forever. When the word spread, the excitement, joy, hope and happiness of his followers could not be described.

We today meet Jesus in our ceremonies, Masses and liturgies. When friends meet, their relationship grows or decreases - it cannot remain the same. So, too, is our friendship with Jesus. St. Paul says “I no longer live, but Christ lives in me”. Good friends influence each other. If you were asked today how more Christ-like are you since this time last year, what answer would you give?

Our friendship with Jesus must be seen in action, in the ways we treat, respect and influence each other in a Christ-like way. The early Christians were respected “see how they love each other”. The Risen Jesus needs us to bring his message of love, hope, and peace into our daily lives. He needs us to be his lights in a society that is just and respectful of all. People need each other. The message of Christ, “Love God, love one another” must be lived in us as his followers. If people can say that I met Christ today through us, then Christ is really risen. He is alive! This Easter time may the Risen Jesus shine through us so that people will have more hope, happiness and the blessings of the Lord in their lives. When we live our ceremonies and liturgies, then Christ can say to us, “thanks for making me alive in 2012”.

May the risen Jesus bless our communities, families, friends and all in need now and for the future.

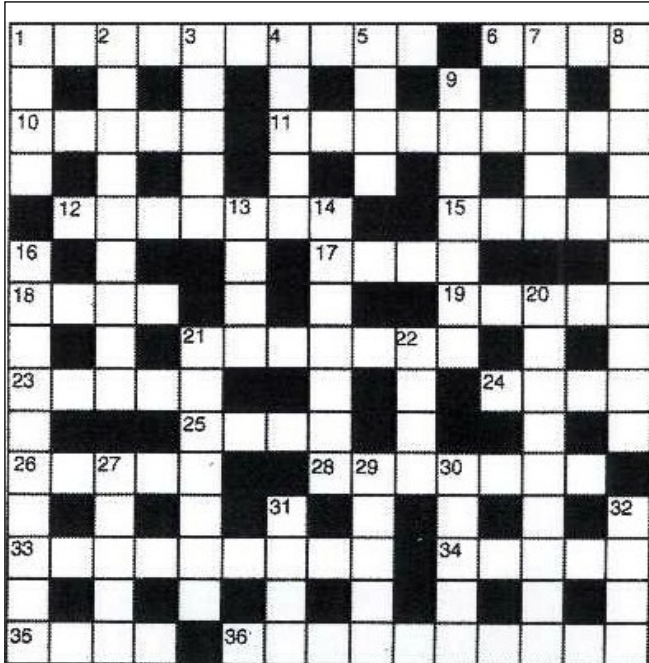
