“THE MOST HOLY TRINITY”

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself and is the source of all the other mysteries of faith. The Holy Trinity is a mystery which is beyond the human mind to fathom. Where do you start? Where do you end? God has no beginning and no end.

Although we speak of the mystery of the Trinity, the word mystery does not imply that nothing can be said of it. Consider this wisdom and light from the ‘Catechism of the Catholic Church’ - “From the beginning the revealed truth of the Holy Trinity has been the very root of the Church’s living faith, principally by means of baptism” (para.249). The teaching of Jesus provides us with a key to open up our understanding of scripture. It encourages us to see all its teaching in the light and context of the Trinity.

Through the scriptures, God progressively and gradually reveals that he is three persons in one God, culminating in the sending of his one and only Son. The secret kept hidden for many ages is that God is God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. When we make the sign of the cross, we proclaim our faith in God as Trinity: “In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit”.

What we believe, from the teaching and tradition of the Catholic Church, is that Jesus constantly speaks of his Father, the Creator, with whom he is completely united and yet, the one who sent him to redeem us. By dying on the cross for us, Jesus became our Redeemer. Before he ascended into heaven, Jesus promises us a helper, the Holy Spirit to inspire, strengthen and give us courage in facing life’s challenges. The Holy Spirit is our Sanctifier.

There can be no doubt that the Church’s greatest minds have grappled with the revelation of the Trinity. The most important truth we need to grasp is that the Blessed Trinity is three divine persons and we are called into a relationship with each one.

“Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit”.

Annual Pentecost Ecumenical Service



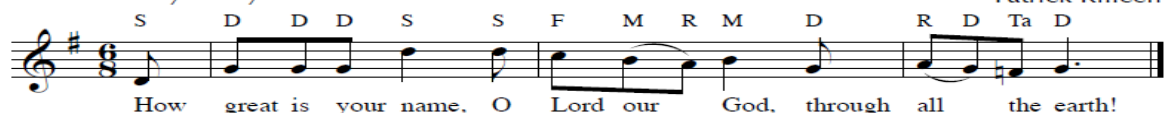

Annual Eucharistic Procession



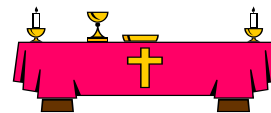
