Dear Parishioners and Friends of Dennehy's Cross Church,

As you can see, the inside of our beautiful Church needs painting and general refurbishment, including heating and lighting. It is hoped to begin this work in September. The work on the surrounding grounds is largely completed at a cost of €80,000 and is fully paid for. In fact we have a reserve of €30,000. The interior work plus what remains of the exterior work, will cost about €110,000. **This means we have to raise €80,000** and we are confident you will help us. If you can afford it, we suggest that you make a once off contribution, increase your weekly contribution or join our weekly envelope scheme (Charities Tax Refund).

With this once off fund raising initiative in place, we are confident that the works will be paid for as they are completed. We would like to assure you that we do not plan on any further special fund raising requests apart from this appeal to support our planned improvement and restoration work.

With your help we want to ensure that we maintain and preserve our Church property in good physical shape so that it will remain an attractive, welcoming, comfortable and holy place for all present and future parishioners to visit and pray together.

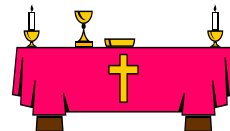
