Five months ago we made an appeal to you as we undertook the renovation of our Church. Now it is our joyful task to let you know that the work has almost been completed and to thank you for your support, patience and your contribution.

We wish to thank all the tradesmen who worked in the Church and took so much pride in their work and were so easy to work with. We want to thank especially those who contributed to the Sunday collection, donated anonymously or took part in the once off contribution to the Renovation Fund. Fr. Bertie and Fr. Tom have already written to thank you individually and where possible enclosed a receipt. Many of your donations will also qualify for the Charities Tax Refund and that will be included in our next application to Revenue in 2016. We thank you all most sincerely and we hope you are as happy as we are with the result.

The total cost of work done externally and internally to the Church in 2014–2015 came to €245,700. The contributions to the Renovation Fund to date came from 240 people and families and realised €101,150. The weekly collection has also contributed and it also helps now that we are fully restored to the Church.

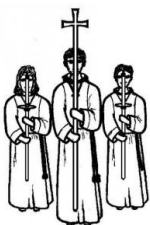
