A CHILLING CHALLENGE

Even though the story has often been retold, there is one very challenging line in this Sunday's Gospel. A huge crowd had followed Jesus and were now weak with hunger. The disciples were hungry too but before they opened up their own meagre supplies, they wanted the mob sent away. After all, the disciples had been far seeing enough to provide for themselves and they did not want to share their resources with the improvident. But Jesus was not co-operative. His command was clear. "There is no need for them to go; give them something to eat yourselves". It is a command that has resonated among Christ's followers over the centuries since. Everywhere the Eucharist is celebrated, the poor and the hungry are cared for, sometimes generously, sometimes less so.

Traditionally, we are a generous people but the temptation to selfishness is never far away and we live in a world whose first commandment is mind oneself. This Gospel constantly reminds us that feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, caring for the less able is at the heart of following Jesus. Religious practice will not substitute for meals on wheels, for aid to Sudan, Myanmar, Focus Ireland, or Simon. To feed the hungry is to be truly a disciple of Jesus. It is our calling.
