Fifty Days

Time is flying; this weekend marks fifty days since Easter. During these past weeks the early signs of a new community emerge, marked by travel, healings, arguments, persecution, and people like Peter finding their voice in a new way. Who would have thought that these scared men, often overshadowed by the bravery of women, would have found their voice, would begin to sound like their teacher, would have shown such faith, such courage? And look at the scene this weekend, described in the Gospel.....confined to the room in fear for their lives! Who or what has made the difference?

The word Pentecost means 'Completion'. Jesus must go from the world to complete what has begun. A power will go into them now, a Spirit must fill their world and fire them into their new journey. Jesus began the work on the Cross, but the world must be alerted to it, and with it, what we know as the church makes its beginnings. In the words of the Preface for Pentecost - Today you sent the Holy Spirit on those marked out to be your children by sharing in the life of your only Son, and so you brought the paschal mystery to its completion.

The sending of the Holy Spirit is the final phase after the Passion, Death and Resurrection to draw us into the intimate and divine life of the only son of God.

Pentecost 1961 marked the completion of the physical work of this house of God, named after the sending of that Spirit on the Apostles and Mary the Mother of Jesus.

May that Spirit rest upon all our thoughts and labours, may it fire us on our own journey of faith!
