Afraid to ask

How often have you been talking to a doctor, a building contractor or a lawyer about the state of your health, an extension to your home, or the boundary of your property and you do not understand what they are saying and were afraid to ask? It can happen especially when we are taken unawares and not able to make a decision properly.

That is the encounter between the disciples and Jesus in the Gospel this weekend. After he confides in them what the journey to Jerusalem would lead to, namely his own suffering and death, they do not understand and are afraid to ask. They begin talking about something else entirely; which of them of them is the greatest. It sounds like they want to talk about anything except what they had just heard. Jesus then does an extraordinary thing: placing a child before them as an example of acceptance and openness.

Unless you become...... answers both their needs. Perhaps if a doctor, lawyer or building contractor spoke slowly to us as if we were a child, without talking down to us. And perhaps if we become like a powerless child more open to events to come, we will not worry ourselves about powers and influence, we might understand more and be less afraid to ask.
