## **The Cry**

This week I found out that a good friend of mine in America lost his job. It had been the fear of his family for some time: threatened lay-offs in a multinational company. He is part of a big family who believe in the power of prayer and support many others in the extended relatives. They cry out in sorrow for him.

At the same time there's a young man locally who cannot get a job in a city crying out for workers. He is of good character and one of deep prayer. He suffers in silence.

The blind beggar cries out this weekend "Son of David, Jesus, have pity on me".

He shouts at a passing Jesus, a man he cannot see, but his only hope. He has been in the darkness enough. Jesus heard him, calls him over; and then something interesting happens: the crowd encourages him: 'Courage', they say, 'get up, he is calling you'. The healing begins there and then. The man named Bartimaeus uses his new sight to follow Jesus along the road. The cry of lamentation is not in vain: Jesus himself will use it in his own Gethsamene, he will cry out his own pain and fear. The Father hears the prayer, the cry reaches the heart of God.

On behalf of the young man and the family man, and all who are suffering right now, we cry out "Son of David, Jesus, have pity on me".
