Face to Face

"**So,** you are a king then?", asks Pilate, Roman Governor. Pilate is in town with a garrison of troops because these big Jewish festivals could lead to riots or national uprising; they were always looking for their own king, instead of the puppet King Herod, who was no threat. And you could not have a greater festival than Passover. This time he has a different type of problem: the Jewish leaders want him to arrest Jesus and condemn him to death. They themselves had no authority or law for this. What accusation could they use? "He claims to be king of the Jews". This man might be the threat that Herod was not. So Pilate and Jesus meet face to face.

**Here** two kingdoms face each other: the kingdom of territory, armies and occupation versus "my kingdom is not of this world". Pilate is genuinely interested until the fullness of the new kingdom is explored by Jesus, no armies or lands but values of truth and justice. Pilate had no mind to pursue these. Jesus was facing his own truth at that moment; he pursued it to the end in the face of mockery and desertion of his closest followers. Pilate did not.

**The** Roman kingdom is now but a memory; the kingdom of justice and truth is alive for all to live by and give witness.
